HOW TO VOTE: Geebung Ski Club's constitution states

3.1.5 If there are more than 8 nominations the secretary must post a ballot paper to every member in addition to the list of nominations. The ballot paper is to list the candidate's names in alphabetical order with a box adjacent to each name.

3.1.6 Members wishing to vote by mail are to fill out the ballot paper by marking a **maximum of 8 boxes** with a **tick or cross** and mailing their completed ballot to the Secretary in sufficient time to be received by the Secretary prior to the annual general meeting. Members attending the annual general meeting who wish to vote may place their completed ballot in a ballot box provided by the Secretary for the purposes of the meeting. Such votes are to be placed in the ballot box prior to the commencement of the meeting.
